

Educational System in Poland



- * The compulsory Education in Poland starts at the age of 5 or 6 (parents' decision)
- * For one year children attend Kindergarden (*Przedszkole* literally Pre-school)
- * Primary School Education lasts for 6 years (grades) and at the end of 6th grade, when children are 13, they have to take a compulsory exam



- * Next step is Junior High (*Gimnazjum*) which lasts 3 years, and ends with another compulsory exam
- * There are few alternatives for the upper secondary level - the most common are 3 years in *Liceum* (High School) or 4 years in *Technikum* (Maths, Technology or ICT oriented)
- * Both end in maturity examination (*Matura*)



* Upper education can lead to:

Bachelor Degree (3 years of education)

Master Degree (another 2 years of education)

Doktor Degree (about 4 years)
